The Delaware Township Recreation Commission will hold a Summer Recreation Program beginning Monday, July 9, 2018 through Friday, July 27, 2018. It will run daily from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., rain or shine, at Delaware Township School. An exciting program of arts, crafts, sports, games, other activities has been planned. All children who are residents of Delaware Township and who will be 5 years old by July 9, 2018 through eighth grade are invited to participate, and encouraged to attend the program.

All campers should come to camp wearing sneakers. The wearing of inadequate footwear will exclude your child from running activities.

A calendar of scheduled events will be distributed on the first day of the program and thereafter as requested. Campers will be encouraged to bring a snack each day as no snacks will be provided. Please be sure to pack a **NUT FREE SNACK**. Please be courteous-NO EARLY DROP-OFFS OR LATE PICK-UPS. All drop-offs and pick-ups will be made from the parking lot on the easterly side of the school. Please do not use the driveway in front of the school. For safety and security reasons, you or your carpool member must pick up your child or children in person. Only students who have completed the sixth grade will be permitted to walk or ride a bike to and from the program with a signed permission slip from a parent or guardian.

We will have visits from Nicola's Food Truck to make your own pizza, an animal program that even includes a camel, the Kona Ice Truck and DJ Mike for a dance party! The Edge Sports Center will be bringing a Ninja Warrior course, Bubble Ball and Archery Tag. And there will also be a water rescue/river safety at Bull's Island and much, much more!

Children can choose to participate in the morning Summer Rec program, the afternoon STEAM program or both. If your child(ren) will be participating in both programs for the full day, they should bring a morning snack, afternoon snack and a bagged lunch.

12:00-3:00

The Delaware Township STEAM Summer Program recognizes the importance of nurturing both sides of the brain, and was created to develop the new thinking skills our young people will need for the future. Art in all forms does this, hence our STEAM Program with an emphasis on art combined with STEM.

Art Program Overview The Art program consists of exciting and engaging activities designed to immerse our future leaders in hands-on art and art history projects.

Painting Workshop Campers will travel through time with paint, using techniques of famous artists such as Henri Rousseau, Wassily Kandinsky, Jean-Michel Basquiat, Georgia O'Keefe and Frida Kahlo. Campers will learn principles of color, theory, dynamics of composition, and a variety of exciting painting techniques. In one exercise —campers will “become the artist” reenacting a famous painting, both by posing/staging and painting.

Intro to 3D Printing Using STEAM as an inspiration, campers will design a 3D sculpture and learn how to create artwork using a 3D printer.

Science Program Overview

The program consists of exciting and engaging activities designed to immerse our future leaders in hands-on science projects.

Science Curriculum Overview

Our program draws upon multiple curriculum programs to present projects that align with nation standards. Topics are being finalized but will draw upon the following:

Polymers

Building upon the DTS Girls Applied Science Club sessions, we will explore the nature and role of polymers with a special focus on creating our own ‘slimes’ and other hands-on polymers.

Water Quality

Water is our most precious resource on Earth. We will explore various aspects of water quality including pollution, desalination, and water pollution.

Space

Building upon the global resurgence in space, we will explore multiple aspects of Space Science including space travel, recent advancements in extra-solar system planet hunting, and subject to final confirmation, our marquee project – sending a weather balloon into space!
